Scholarship Program

The Talanx-Stiftung, whose activities mainly focus on the insurance related disciplines at the selected¹ universities of Leibniz University Hannover, the University Leipzig, the University of Cologne, the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology and the University of Ulm, grants up to ten scholarships per semester.

Funding will start at the earliest after two semesters of study. The scholarship will be granted for a maximum of two semesters at a time, however extensions up to the end of the regular study period are possible. The scholarship amounts to 300 EUR per month for living expenses. Proposals for candidates for the scholarships, as well as recommendations for the renewal of scholarships, are to be submitted exclusively by the selected departments / institutes of said universities. Self-nominations by the students will generally not be accepted by the foundation.

Apart from academic excellence social commitment - in the form of volunteer activities for example - can additionally be taken into consideration. A possible further criterion may be the lack of adequate financial support which makes it difficult for the student to complete his or her course of studies in the stipulated period of time and with grades corresponding to his or her abilities.

The Board of the foundation decides on the award of the scholarships and their renewal.

The Board of directors of the foundation decides biannually (in January and July) on the granting of the scholarships. Thus applications and extensions for financial support by the foundation are to be handed in at the latest by May 31 or November 30 respectively.
